SPRING PARTY was unhurried early then rallied on the inside on the far turn, made a bid but was second best. PERF set the early pace then drew off on the run down the backstretch, was well handled then was used up on the far turn and gave way in the stretch. LIVIN LOVIN chased the pace while racing two wide, rallied on the far turn then failed to respond in the stretch and faltered. ELEGANT KINDNESS was unhurried early and was no threat. TRUCK RIDE chased the early pace while inside, was used up and stopped.
