Footnotes

GULLY HILL ROAD stalked the pace four wide, bid at the quarter pole and was up late under a steady drive. HEART OF A KING led inside, bid at the quarter pole to be clear, then couldn't hold off the winner. BOYFRIENDONTHE SIDE saved ground early, bid three wide at the three-sixteenths pole but hung in the drive. SONNY'S MEMORY improved position late while eight wide. FASTER THAN FLASH had his head turned in the gate, broke back of the field and rallied belatedly inside. CRIMSON SUN raced evenly four wide. REMARKABLE STORM pressed the early pace three wide, then was steadied at the three-eighths pole in tight quarters. WINITBACK passed tired rivals while seven wide. WHO NEEDS TO KNOW and MY TUNE pressed the pace outside of the leader, then faded in the drive.
