LUCKY MEMENTO was void of early speed, had a steady advance to reach the leaders, finished fast in the middle of the track to gain the lead and drew clear. SEE I A was away alertly to grab the early lead, went well rated while saving ground, was outfinished but held the place. SIR RABBIT unhurried early, saved ground along the backside, swung wide and had a mild rally. BRINEY LAD was well placed, weakened. ROSA PANTERA stalked the pace, saved ground but flattened out. BUBBER settled in the middle of the pack, had no rally. EVENTUALLY WILD was no factor. ROCKEM SOCKEM pressed the pace, stopped and was eased to the wire.
