Footnotes

J T KINGFISHER bid three wide at the three-eighths pole and was up late under a steady drive. SUNSHINE BO stalked the pace four wide, bid at the three-eighths pole, led late but couldn't hold off the winner. COLD FEET led inside, then gave way late. FINGER TAPPING pressed the pace for a half mile before yielding. LUIGI'S HONOUR stalked the pace between rivals, then lacked a late bid. SYNCOPATION stalked the pace inside for a half mile. COME ON OVER and JARACAT were not factors.
