### Footnotes

LEATHERHEAD stalked the pace between foes, bid four wide at the quarter pole and was up late under a strong drive. ONE COOL DUDE (ARG) was unrushed four wide, bid five wide on the far turn, surged late and just missed. SEA FORECASTOR pressed the pace outside of the leader, then faded late. TASTE THE TRUTH led inside, then gave way late. BURI stalked the pace four wide, then lacked a late bid. ZYDECO BLUES saved ground to no avail. FEBRUARY CUPID pressed the pace inside before fading in the stretch. HIT KING was not a factor. ROMA'S WORLD was off a step slow, then raced evenly four wide. NAJRAIN stalked the early pace between foes, bid three wide at the three-quarters pole, then faltered after a half mile.
