TRULY AMAZING stalked the pace inside, rallied at the quarter pole and was clear late under mild urging. CORONET OF A BARON saved ground, angled out five wide in the stretch and rallied but couldn't get to the winner. QUARTERSAWN saved ground, then bid belatedly. ORDINATION (IRE) was bumped at the start, pressed the early pace between foes, then gave way in the stretch. TAXES FOR BEN was improved position late three wide. KEY TO A CURE raced evenly four wide. CALCULATING JIMMY was bumped at the start, led inside, then gave way late. TEMP raced evenly outside. HYSTERICAL CAT pressed the early pace three wide, then faded after a half mile. EVERYBODY'S DADDY was not a factor.
