TERRIFFICO was well placed early in mid pack, rallied on the outside into the stretch and took the lead, drew clear under heavy pressure. INDY O. was away alertly and set the pace while off the rail, could not go with the winner late but was second best. DYNAMIC DAN was well placed in mid pack, rallied on the turn while five wide, flattened out and ran evenly late. LABOR UNION was unhurried early while on the outside, rallied into the stretch but found his best stride late and was gaining. TEJANOS ELIMINATOR was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly and had no rally. HOLY VESPER showed good early speed chasing the pace from the inside, ran evenly and had no rally. STORY TELLER flashed brief speed before stopping. SING TO REASON showed good early speed on the outside, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. D WISE GUY was no factor while six and seven wide and lost ground. BLUES CROSSING was no threat. THUNDER MOUNTAIN failed to menace.
