QUITE ACCEPTABLE was settled in the early going then started a run on the far turn while three wide, swung out to be six wide in upper stretch then was in a strong drive and lugged in just past the furlong marker and caused crowding then drew off in late stretch to prove best. POWERSTOWN set a well handled pace from the start, was collared on the far turn and dueled to mid stretch then long drive but tired in late stretch. LUCKY DRAGON was inside and saving ground on the run down the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn then angled out in mid stretch making a bid but hung in late stretch. J T KINGFISHER was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while four wide, swung out to be seven wide in upper stretch and made a mild gain in late stretch. HAY PRINCE was unhurried early and settled on the run down the backstretch, rallied on the far turn then was five wide in the stretch, was in tight quarters and bumped with ART OF DIPLOMACY just past the furlong marker then steadied off heels and tired. DYNHOCRACY was well placed while inside then moved up to duel for the lead on the far turn to mid stretch, was in a long drive but faltered in late stretch. ART OF DIPLOMACY chased the early pace while racing three wide, made a bid on the far turn then was bumped in mid stretch and faltered. POLISH TRICK was unhurried early while racing four wide on the backstretch, made a five wide middle move on the far turn then flattened out in the stretch drive. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of HAY PRINCE against the rider of QUITE ACCEPTABLE for interference just past the furlong marker. After reviewing the films, the stewards disqualified QUITE ACCEPTABLE from first and placed him fifth for interference in the stretch.
