STUMBLING BLOCK was unhurried early then started a run on the far turn, moved out to be four wide for the stretch, was in a strong stretch drive and powered to the front in late stretch. SWIFT STRIKE was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and finished well to be second best. SIR RABBIT broke in and bumped at the start, stalked the pace while inside then rallied on the far turn, made a bid three wide in the stretch but hung in late stretch. BIPOLAR EXPRESS dueled for the lead while two wide, was well handled then drew off in upper stretch to mid stretch but weakened in late stretch. OUR TIME was bumped at the start then unhurried early, raced on the inside on the far turn but failed to menace in the stretch. DISTORTED GEM dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive throughout while being hard used on the far turn then gave way in the stretch drive. BRIDLED QUEST was well placed while racing three wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. I'M WAITING FOR U was four wide on the backstretch then failed to respond when asked on the far turn.
