BIG CARLOS PASS stalked the pace from three wide,responded when asked and finished well in the middle of the track to gain command,drew clear under strong handling. THE FOURTH ESTATE had good position early,found his best stride and rallied in late stretch to get up for the place. LE BON TON ROULE set a pressured pace,dueled from between horses till mid stretch but weakened. ZEALOUS YANKEE pressed the pace,saved ground,flattened out mid stretch. MR. ARGUMENT was well placed,lacked a late response. CUP OF WHYS was void of early speed,passed tiring rivals in the stretch. PROUD VALAY was no threat. APPEALING IMAGE raced in the second flight,had no rally. DYNATOUGH settled in the middle of the pack,faded. SILENT TAP was slow early and never close.
