DANCEHALL FEVER vied four wide, then prevailed late under a strong drive. YOUNGBLOOD stalked the pace between rivals, bid inside at the three-sixteenths pole but was outfinished. HE'S APPEALING pressed the pace three wide, bid at the quarter pole but was outfinished. WILD DEPOSIT vied between rivals, then gave way late. SIR ROMEO raced four wide, angled out seven wide in the stretch, then had no gain. SLICK TALKING was hesitant and was bumped at the start. BIG ROYAL ELTISH was not a factor. BIG CITY PAT vied inside, then gave way in the drive.
