BRUNO FRIGERIO pressed the pace four wide, dueled outside through the stretch and was up late under a mild drive. WOODSWIND led inside, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished. SAINTLY TALE had a mild late bid while three wide. SIPPIN THE DEW vied between rivals, then was squeezed back at the half-mile pole. AFFAIR INTHE WOODS raced evenly five wide. WELL SEASONED saved ground to no avail. BLACK KNIGHT faded in the stretch. MIRKWOOD FOREST was pinballed at the start, pressed the early pace three wide, then faded.
