BLUE MON was unhurried early then started a run heading into the far turn, saved ground on the far turn then moved out to be two wide at the quarter pole, was in a strong drive then lugged in throughout but drew off in late stretch. RAILROADED set a well handled pace from the start, drew off on the far turn then weakened in late stretch while holding the place safe in the end. MY BALLETT was settled in the early going then rallied three wide on the far turn, made a strong bid to mid stretch then came up empty in late stretch. ROMAN VALOR was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, made a bid four wide in upper stretch but flattened out in the stretch drive. SLICE OF GLORY stalked the pace while inside on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then faltered in the stretch. DAWN'S REVENGE was allowed to settle while inside on the backstretch, dropped back on the far turn and was no threat. MAGIC KIPPER pressed the early pace while two wide, was used up and gave way on the far turn. MARSHALL ROOSTER (GB) was unhurried early and was no factor. WE HAVE A PROBLEM raced four wide on the backstretch, continued four wide on the far turn then drifted out in the stretch while being no factor.
