CORRUPT had good position behind the dueling leaders,moved closer from four wide on the far turn,gained command mid stretch but was all out to prevail. BUDGE MAN was void of early speed,trailed entering the far turn,swung wide and finished full of run to just miss. SUNSHINE BO stalked the pace while in hand,rallied from between horses to challenge mid stretch,lacked a late response. SUITE ERNIE B unhurried early,swung wide,closed willingly. SHILAH was slow early,raced five wide throughout and had no rally. RED DESERT ANGEL pressed the pace and weakened. LOFTY AND NOBLE chased the lead from three wide,flattened out. BIPOLAR EXPRESS set a pressured pace,gave way and faltered.
