CAJUN PRIZE bid five wide at the three-eighths pole, was clear late, then lasted under a strong drive. GREAT SHOT stalked the pace inside, rallied late four wide, then couldn't catch the winner. C R'S DEPUTY was unrushed early, then rallied belatedly six wide. LAINIES LION bid four wide at the half-mile pole, then gave way late. WANNABE bid three wide at the half-mile pole before giving way late. SPARKLING SPRINGS and. ANGLERS REEF had mild late bids outside. RIP RAP saved ground, then lacked a late bid. CITY SNEAKERS dueled inside, then gave way in the drive. CLASSICAL RHYTHM pressed the early pace before giving way. O'GULCH dueled outside the leader before giving way on the far turn.
