TWENTYTWO AND TWO stalked the pace four wide, bid in the stretch, dueled, was brushed late by the leader and was up in time. THREE KNOCKS was clear early inside, then drifted out late and was outfinished. MIDLAND stalked the pace between foes, rallied five wide and missed. CROWN THE PRINCE pressed the pace three wide, then lacked a late bid. WISEMAN saved ground, angled out three wide at the eighth pole for running room and had a mild late bid. RARE MARK pressed the early pace between foes, then gave way in the drive. NATIVE SOLEIL angled out seven wide in the stretch, then lacked a late bid. DEVINESCATCHDCAT was off awkwardly.
