FAIRLY ROYAL rallied four wide at the five-sixteenths pole and was up late under a strong drive. SNOW FAIR stalked the pace between rivals, bid at the quarter pole but was outfinished. COMIC MISS saved ground, bid at the quarter pole, then faltered in the drive. SYLVIA TWICE stalked the pace three wide, then lacked a late bid. STARDAZZLE was squeezed back at the start. TRACI LEA was off awkwardly. SISTER LOIS pressed the early pace, then gave way. TALENTED TWIST led inside, then gave way in the drive.
