**Footnotes**

NASREEN stalked the early pace outside of the leader, bid at the quarter pole and drew off under a strong drive. REGINA TWAIN stalked the early pace three wide, bid at the quarter pole and was the best of the rest. STREET SUCCESS improved position late six wide despite being bumped at the three-sixteenths pole. BURNING AMOR had some late gain inside. LADY LOHR raced evenly four wide. SEPTEMBERSHALFMOON was jostled at the start, bid five wide, then was carried out at the three-sixteenths pole into a rival. MISS DOLAN'S ROSE was jostled at the start, stalked the pace inside, then faded in the stretch. CONNIE'S JUNE MOON was off awkwardly, saved ground, ducked out at the three-sixteenths pole, then faded in the stretch while four wide. DRY WITH A TWIST was not a factor. TRICKIN G was clear early, then gave way in the drive.
