**Footnotes**

CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE duelled for the lead and set the pace from between horses, was taken to the rail in the stretch, was headed in upper stretch, came again late to prevail in a long drive. VIVACI stalked the pace while never far back on the outside, rallied into the stretch and led briefly, was grudgingly outfinished. MERCANTILE was well placed in mid pack, rallied into the stretch but found his best stride late and was gaining. BOWDRILL was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly throughout and had no rally. CALL ME CAL stalked the pace from the outside with good early speed, faltered in the stretch and faded. LUNAR MODULE was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch and was no threat. TOMMY CEE duelled for the lead and set the pace, faltered in the stretch and dropped back. NINENINENINE was no factor. IMSTILLSTANDIN failed to menace. CLASSIC CRACKER flashed brief speed before fading.
