LUCKY STRIKES GOLD rallied inside on the far turn, angled out six wide into the stretch, then rallied and was up late under a mild drive. PELEADORA FUERTE angled out four wide at the five-sixteenths pole, rallied, then was outfinished at the wire. SILENT JOY pressed the pace between rivals, bid at the quarter pole, then couldn't hold off the closers. BRUSHFIREAIRYTALE stalked the pace inside, then gave way in the drive. COCOA'S IMAGE led inside, then faded in the drive. MAMA LULU raced evenly five wide. LADY OF RIVENDELL stalked the pace between rivals, then gave way on the far turn. LETTER TO HENNY was off awkwardly, then pressed the pace four wide for a half mile before giving way.
