RAGS OLD IRON stalked the pace inside, angled out three wide at the three-sixteenths pole, rallied and was up late under a steady drive. CODE BLUE was clear early inside, was challenged at the quarter pole, bid, then couldn't hold off the winner. MATZ saved ground, then rallied belatedly. FRANK THE TANK stalked the pace between rivals, angled out six wide in the stretch, but failed to menace. KEEP THE CHIEF pressed the pace outside of the leader, bid at the quarter pole, then faltered in the drive. TOURING PRO stalked the pace three wide, then faded in the drive. HAWKINSVILLE was off awkwardly. VORTEEVA was not a factor. BLUES BROTHER was through early.
