POSTPONE was bumped hard at the start, stalked the pace inside, rallied at the eighth pole and drew off under a mild drive. FREUDIAN DILEMMA rallied five wide at the three-sixteenths pole, then couldn't match strides with the winner. PRESIDENT EATON vied between foes, lugged out at the three-sixteenths pole, then lacked a late bid. ZEALOUS YANKEE vied three wide, was bumped at the three-sixteenths pole, then faded. SEIZE THE FIRE was off awkwardly. TALKIN CASH raced evenly. ALAJWAD DANCER veered in at the start, bothering the winner, was rank early, then lugged out in the stretch. WILD BLING stalked the pace four wide, then faded on the turn. MASTERPIECE led inside, then gave way in the drive.
