Footnotes

GAYEGO stalked the early pace down the backside from three while in hand, moved closer entering the far turn while between horses, was set down and responded to edge clear in late stretch under strong handling SUCCESSFUL DAN pressed the pace from two wide, inched closer entering the far turn, gained a slight advantage coming out of the turn, battled with the winner but was no match late. STUNNING STAG was allowed to settle into stride, had good position early while four wide, moved up on the far turn to be a factor, lacked a late rally in the stretch. ALLIE'S EVENT was unhurried early, settled in between horses, angled out on the far turn and closed willingly. BLACK BELT rushed to the lead along the inside, saved ground down the backside, duelled when hooked on the far turn, weakened through the stretch. MAMBO MEISTER settled in mid pack, saved ground down the backside, slipped through along the inside to reach contention, failed to respond. CHEROKEE ARTIST was void of early speed, circled the field to be a threat, flattened out. ROCKIN' ROCKSTAR was slow early, trailed far back, was never involved. I KNOW WHY dropped to the rail on the first turn, saved ground throughout, had no rally.
