ROYAL WAR ACADEMY never far back, chased the early leaders, was unable to gain but held the place. TWO CATS was hustled along, stalked the pace on the rail, lacked a late response. ALLSAROTT void of early speed, had a steady advance, finished with a mild rally. MONHOCRACY raced in the second flight in the early going, swung wide for the drive, failed to respond. ACK MAGICAL had good position, flattened out. BUSINESS FACTOR trailed in a dull effort.
