**Footnotes**

ONE COOL DUDE (ARG) stalked the pace, rallied late three wide and was clear under a mild drive. FEBRUARY CUPID led between rivals, then couldn't hold off the winner. BOWDRIE pressed the pace three wide, then lacked a late bid. FAVORITE HOUR angled out five wide at the top of the stretch, then bid late. BRUSH TO CLEAR was off awkwardly, angled out six wide at the top of the stretch and rallied. KING BEE stalked the pace inside, then gave way in the drive. MILL BAY saved ground, angled out seven wide at the top of the stretch, then lacked a late bid. ZYDECO BLUES raced four wide, then faded on the turn. PRETTY GOOD stalked the pace four wide, bid at the quarter pole, then faded in the drive. KENDALLS BEAR stalked the pace five wide, then faded in the drive. PIZZARIA was off awkwardly, then showed nothing. PIZZARIA was mistakenly scratched by officials, then was allowed to race "for purse only."
