Footnotes

FIRST FROST reserved off the early pace to the far turn, ranged up two wide, angled out five wide at the quarter pole, swept past rivals in mid-stretch and drew away in the final hundred yards. AVANZANDO rated along the rail through the turn, rallied gamely along the fence to mid-stretch, crowded by DUVALI into rail, rushed through inside hole when given the opportunity and was up for the place. DAGBURNIT tracked the leaders from a clear pocket along the fence to the quarter pole, angled four wide to challenge, loomed boldly at the eighth pole and was outfinished to the wire. BOWMAN'S SAM dueled on the pace from three wide to mid-stretch and weakened in the final eighth. MAIN SPRING rated in the middle of the field and made a mild bid through the stretch. PRO GOLD raced near the rear of the field to the top of the lane and passed tired rivals through the stretch. DUVALI rushed to battle from the rail in a three-way duel for the lead to the quarter pole and tired in the drive. A LAUGH AN A JOKE pressed the pace from between horses to the quarter pole and gave way. BERRA raced evenly. FREEKIN trailed throughout.
