Footnotes

KINGOFTHEWEST was unhurried early and kept to the inside, rallied on the far turn then swung out to be two wide at the quarter pole, was in a long drive in the stretch and proved best in the end. PRAY FOR WAR was settled on the run down the backstretch while being three wide, made a strong bid on the far turn and was four wide at the top of the stretch, dug in gamely in the drive but was outfinished for the win. MUSTARD SEED was allowed to settle in the early going, started a run on the far turn while three wide, was in a long drive in the stretch but came up empty in late stretch. CATCH FINI was unhurried early and raced two wide on the far turn then failed to menace in the stretch. AL NASR'S PRINCE set the early pace, opened up a clear lead on the backstretch, was used up and gave way in the stretch drive. CRUGUET (ARG) was very hard to load then raced on the inside on the backstretch and far turn but failed to menace. NATIVE SOLEIL chased the early pace from the inside, bore out on the far turn and gave way in the drive.
