CHEROKEE ARTIST was settled in the early going then was in hand on the run down the backstretch, moved up heading into the far turn then rallied three wide, was in a long sustained drive on the outside in the stretch and proved best in late stretch. J'S SUNDANCE HALO set a well rated pace from the start, was well rated while inside then was in a long drive on the far turn and stretch but tired in late stretch. THE ROUNDHOUSE was unhurried early then rallied four wide on far turn, swung out in upper stretch and closed willingly in late stretch. VACATION was unhurried in the early going, rallied three wide on the far turn making a bid but came up empty in late stretch. MOTOVATO was allowed to settle while racing on the inside down the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn making a bid but came up empty in late stretch. JADE'S REVENGE was unhurried early while racing four wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn but failed to menace in the stretch. LUCK MONEY (IRE) raced three wide on the backstretch, made a middle move to stalked the pace then was used up and stopped on the far turn. SEA DUBAI chased the early pace while racing three wide, bore out nearing the half mild pole then stopped on the far turn.
