**Footnotes**

LOST SWORD led between rivals, drew off in the stretch, then just lasted under strong urging. BLUE MON was unrushed between foes, angled in to the rail at the eighth pole, rallied and missed. GOOD FAMILY stalked the pace between foes, bid at the quarter pole, then couldn't sustain that bid. HISTORICALLY improved position late four wide. HIGH ASPIRATIONS angled out seven wide in the stretch and improved position. J T KINGFISHER stalked the pace inside, then gave way in the stretch. SIX CLICKS stalked the early pace four wide, bid at the quarter pole, then gave way in the drive. CALL TIGER improved position late four wide. PRINCE RAFFIE was not a factor. HOUSE OF USHER stalked the pace three wide, then faded in the stretch. DANCE WORLD stalked the early pace four wide, then faded. ONESHOTAWAY was not a factor.
