MIDSTATESMAN bore out at the start, pressed the pace outside, bid at the eighth pole to be clear, then lasted under a mild drive. STICKY CACTUS saved ground, bid belatedly three wide but couldn't get to the winner. LORI'S COACH was bumped at the start, was clear early, then gave way late. GOOD MOVER stalked the pace three wide, bid at the quarter pole but faltered late. MIDLAND raced evenly four wide. JACK ARMSTRONG was off awkwardly, saved ground, then lacked a late bid. MONARCH DESTINY was steadied in the early going, then raced evenly. TINTERN ABBEY saved ground to no avail. FREE AND FLASHY passed tired rivals. DRAGON HORN was not a factor. FIFTYNINE faded.
