INDEPENDENT GEORGE stalked the pace while never far back to the outside of the pacesetter, rallied on the second turn and dueled for the lead, drew clear entering the stretch, was under firm handling to the finish. BESTOWED was unhurried early on the outside, rallied on the second turn and loomed a threat, could not go with the winner in the stretch but was clearly second best. REAL DANDY was void of early speed on the inside, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and began to fade in the drive. MASTER OF DISASTER set the slow pace while off the rail, led to upper stretch, weakened in the drive and dropped back. TASHBAAN was unhurried early on the outside, rallied on the second turn, failed to sustain the bid and dropped back. BARBICAN stalked the pace with good early speed, gave way in the stretch and faded. SUPER FROLIC was well placed while saving ground, was pulled up nearing the half mile pole and vanned off.
