INDIAN CHANT stalked and prompted the early pace from the outside, drew off in upper stretch, was under right handed urging to the finish. SANTANA STRINGS was unhurried early on the outside, rallied into the stretch and was gaining but too late. CONNECTIONS was in a good stalking position on the outside in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, found his best stride late and had some late gain. BERNIE BLUE was well placed in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. DIXIE MOON set the pace while saving ground, faltered in the stretch and faded. JOEY P. stalked the pace with good early speed on the outside in mid pack, had no rally. HE'S GOT GRIT showed good early speed from the inside, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. IMPLICIT lunged at the start, failed to menace.
