MORNING PRAYERS raced evenly between rivals. BLUEGRASS GIRL rallied belatedly five wide. EXECUTIVELY raced evenly between rivals. PEGASUS AJUDA hopped and was pinballed at the start. KITTY AFLEET saved ground to no avail. BLAZINETT stalked the pace three wide, then faded in the drive. WHATHEMATTERHEART stalked the pace five wide, then faded in the drive.
