Footnotes

MASTERWORK was unhurried early then rallied three wide on the far turn, was in a long drive while three wide in the stretch and proved best in the end. DEVIL APPROVED IT was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn, was in a long drive in the stretch then was outfinished in late stretch. REFINED DESIGN threw it's head at the start then was settled, saved ground on the far turn then rallied along the inside in the stretch and gamely dug in to finish well. CHIMCHAR stalked the early pace while racing two wide, rallied on the far turn to gain command then drew off in upper stretch but weakened in the end. SLANEY ROCK (IRE) was allowed to settle in the early going, rallied three wide on the far turn making a bid then flattened out in late stretch. SECOND THOUGHTS was unhurried early then raced two wide on the far turn but failed to menace in the stretch. TURNPIKE TERRY was unhurried early then raced four wide on the far turn and was no threat. MR. JOLSON was sent along to set the early pace, was used up and gave way in the stretch. TILLMAN HALL was well placed while racing three wide, was used up and stopped.
