Footnotes

SOPHIE'S SPLINTER was taken back soon after the start, was allowed to settle, made a steady advance to reach the leaders, finished well to get up in the final strides. THINKING OUT LOUD had good position, rallied from between horses, dueled to the wire and just missed. BRINEY LAD stalked the pace, lacked a late response. SHINE ON was void of early speed, angled out at the top of the stretch and closed willingly. CIRQUE DU SOLEIL (ARG) was away alertly, set a pressured pace along the inside, gave way. KAPTAIN pressed the pace from three wide, faltered in the stretch. WILD SUNDAY (GB) raced mid pack early, moved quickly at the half to challenge, faded. SCHIFTY'S PROSPECT showed little.
