E OR stalked the pace inside, rallied at the quarter pole, was checked at the three-sixteenths pole when lacking running room, altered course out three wide to collar the leader and was bumped late before being clear. TASTE THE TRUTH was clear early, drifted out late and couldn't hold off the winner. SUNSHINE RICHARD was off a step slowly, then rallied belatedly while six wide. PHILOLOGY saved ground, then lacked a late bid. CELTIC HEIR stalked the pace four wide, then lacked a late bid. A. K. A. BURNIE and YES SIR OFFICER raced evenly. DENALI SURPRISE stalked the pace for a half mile before fading in the drive. RAIN OF GLORY was through early. FIRST REQUEST was through early and was distanced. RIDGEROD bobbled the start, then was outrun and distanced.
