DIVINE INDY stumbled leaving the gate to give the field a three length advantage, slowly worked his way into contention along the rail down the backside, waited behind rivals through the turn, angled out splitting horses in upper stretch and closed with a flourish in the final hundred yards to be up in time. PELEADORA FUERTE sped off in the first turn to wrestle command from JAMRAA, opened a clear, well rated lead down the backstretch, responded well when challenged in upper stretch and was just caught in final yards. JAMRAA away alertly to duel for the early lead, settled back to stalk the pace to the far turn, moved to engage the leader in upper stretch but could not get by the runner-up. EVANSVILLE ABBIE tracked the pace from two wide down the backstretch, mounted a mild rally in the turn and finished evenly lacking a threatening response. SHALL WE GATHER trailed for most of the way and passed a tiring rival in the stretch. HOT FRENCH FRIES moved up the rail to a prominent stalking position to the far turn and gave way leaving the quarter pole tiring through the stretch.
