TERREMOTICO was well placed while racing three wide, rallied on the turn then was in a long drive while three wide in the stretch and proved best in the end. RONALDO was settled early on then rallied on the turn, rallied in upper stretch then lugged in mid stretch and closed fast while four wide and just missed in the end. ROVING dueled for the lead while inside, was in a long drive throughout the stretch but tired in deep stretch. AFLEET BAY was well placed then rallied four wide on the turn, was in a long drive to make a bid to late stretch but hung in the end. GIVE ME SOME GREEN dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long sustained drive then weakened in late stretch. BAD BOY LUKE on the inside and saving ground on the turn but lacked a rally in the stretch. STALWART SON lunged at the start then hustled along to be four wide on the turn and faltered in the stretch drive. PAPER WAITE was outrun. COSTA BLANCA broke out at the start then raced four wide on the turn and faltered in the stretch.
