O'SHEA was unrushed early, rallied six wide at the eighth pole and was up in time under a strong drive. BARAN'S PROSPECT stalked the pace three wide, bid at the three-eighths pole, dueled through the stretch, led late and outfinished. SECRET CITIZEN stalked the pace between foes, bid at the three-eighths pole, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished. STREET TRADER was unrushed early, then rallied at the three-sixteenths pole and closed along the rail. JT'S BIG DREAM bid five wide at the quarter pole, then hung in the drive. ORO VERDADERO raced evenly between foes. STRATEGIES stalked the pace, bid at the half-mile pole, then gave way in the drive. MO' TERMS saved ground, bid at the half-mile pole, then faded on the turn. DR. HOWARD stumbled at the start, was clear early, then gave way in the drive.
