SAMMY'S D J stalked the pace while saving ground, rallied into the stretch and took the lead, drew off under firm handling. THE LAST SPY set the pace to mid stretch while off the rail, responded when challenged in the stretch, could not go with the winner but was second best. THE COLOR RED was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly and had no rally. BROOKE HALEY was unhurried early, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and began to fade. CHA CHA BROWN stalked and pressed the pace from the outside, flattered in the stretch and began to fade. CANDY MILL was no factor but did improve position. SILK CAT was well placed early on the outside, rallied on the turn, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. LILYBOO was no factor. FEATHER HILL showed good early speed chasing the pace, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
