PEACEFUL SLEWTION off a step slow from the foes, rushed up to weave his way through traffic, reached a striking position entering the turn, altered outside for the drive and wore down SPEED AWAY the final furlong. SPEED AWAY dueled from the inside for the early lead, shook loose entering the turn, opened a clear margin at the eighth pole but was caught the final furlong. I HAVE NO I D far back early while inside rivals, advanced entering the turn, altered outside and finished well. TALE OF THE TAPE well placed from the inside, made a bid entering the drive but could not keep pace. STAR OF NAVARONE never far back early, had no late response. DEPUTY CATON went evenly. QUIET DOWN COWBOY was no factor. AL NASR'S PRINCE dueled from the outside and tired. BUTCHIE THE HAT broke in at the start and was no factor. BOB'S PRIDE had a steady fade.
