Footnotes

EN EL FUEGO was well placed early in mid pack, rallied on the far turn and drew clear in upper stretch, was under constant handling to add to the margin late. JUDITH'S LAKE was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch, could not get to and was no match for the winner, was clearly second best. STORM THIEF dueled for the lead and set the pace from the outside with good early speed, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. PRINCE NICK was unhurried early, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. DISBELIEF was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain. FOG BUSTER stalked the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. LUCKY DRUMMER dueled for the lead from the inside, faltered in the stretch and faded. MEDIGATING (FR) failed to menace. MR. MABEE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, had no rally. SKYEY showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back.
