### Footnotes

MEDAGLIA'S EXPRESS saved ground, bid between rivals 1/4, then drew off under a mild drive. TOBES THE MAN dueled outside of a foe, bid at the three-eighths pole, then couldn't hold off the winner. EMERALD CRESCENT rallied seven wide at the quarter pole and closed. SPUNK stalked the pace three wide, then lacked a late bid. MISTER MONSIEUR raced evenly between foes. FLIRTING FOR LOVE improved position late inside. STOP HUNTING raced evenly five wide. IFOUNDMY MOJO stalked the pace three wide, bid at the three-eighths pole, then gave way. SKIP TO THE NORTH was not a factor. HOBOTOHERO ducked in at the gap, bid at the quarter pole, then was taken up late when a rival was giving way in front on him. FRANKIE SAYS RELAX dueled inside, then gave way after a half.
