BAROSSA set a pressured pace down the backside, shook clear on the turn, dug in when hooked mid stretch, inched clear under strong handling. WILD SUNDAY (GB) had good position, rallied to draw even mid stretch, dueled but was outfinished. SHORE EXCURSION stalked the pace in hand, waited for room from between horses, lacked a late response when clear. DONERAILE'S PEAK slow early, best his best stride late. SHILAH was allowed to settle, swung six wide, had a mild rally. MATTY'S SONG raced in the second flight, offered no rally. BIG BRIAN T raced evenly. POLITE LIL SIR saved ground to no avail. THE WRECKER was no threat. BUJAGALI was away alertly, chased the leader, stopped along the rail. CAPTAIN KYLE was no factor. SAFSOOF was taken back, swung seven wide, failed to respond.
