AWESOME VOW was clear early, then drew off under a mild drive. KAY WAR was unrushed early between rivals, bid late on the rail, then gained the place late. PELEADORA FUERTE bid six wide at the quarter pole, then was no match in the drive. BEWITCHING ANNA was fractious in the gate, pressed the pace three wide, then faded in the stretch. SCREAMING REGAL stalked the early pace before fading in the drive. SYLVIA TWICE pressed the pace inside, then faded in the drive. CARTIER LADY bid four wide at the half-mile marker, then faltered on the far turn. VERTICAL LIFT saved ground to no avail.
