SEVENISTHENUMBER was allowed to settle, rallied on the turn to get closer,finished full of run from between horses to gain the lead late stretch and drew clear. GOOD MOVER checked at the 1/2 mile pole, dropped back sharply, settled in to save ground , slipped through along the rail and finished well to gain the place. MIDLAND had good position, closed willingly. FULL RECOVERY was hustled along to set the early pace, shook clear and opened up turning for home, shortened stride and weakened along the rail mid stretch. CHIEF BUFFALO slow early, swung eight wide, passed tiring rivals. WOKE UP RUNNIN' showed little while five wide. GOT HENNESSY failed to menace. GENTLEMAN CALLER flashed good early speed from five wide, flattened out. DUE D' TOUR pressed the pace, gave way along the rail. SPORTING BOY was through after a half. WORD OF ADVICE was no factor. DEWANNA CAT trailed in a dull effort.
