TACTICAL CANDY dueled for the lead from the inside early, drew clear on the turn, was under heavy pressure to hold the margin late. VICTORIOUS HALO stalked the pace while saving ground, was angled out in the stretch and rallied, was gaining but too late. GRAN NIETA was unhurried early, had a mild late rally and some late gain. ALL BOLD was void of early speed while six wide, was fanned near mid track and lost ground, had a mild late rally and some late gain. KITTY KISSES bobbled at the start, was rushed to contention, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. SKY was in a good stalking position in mid pack, had no rally. MY PHILLY prompted the pace with good early speed, gave way in the stretch and dropped back.
