FRIENDLY SEA was taken in hand to trail in the early going, had a steady middle move to reach the leaders, finished full of run to get the lead and drew clear under heavy pressure. ONESHOTAWAY stalked the pace, closed willingly to gain the place while no match for the winner. ALPHABET MAGIC was hustled along, set a pressured pace, dueled in fast fractions, faltered in the stretch. CRAFTY MARK pressed the pace, dueled with ALPHABET MAGIC, weakened from his efforts. SCOURGE well placed, failed to respond. DIAMOND LURE showed little in a dull effort.
