RELIGIOUS ED was unhurried early, raced between horses around the far turn, found his best stride mid stretch and wore down rivals in the final yards. HEY JOHNNY JOHNNY pressed the pace early, gained a narrow advantage mid stretch, dueled but was outfinished. VALANCE was void of early speed, saved ground, angled out and finished well. DINNER TRAIN well placed early, was hustled along, slipped through along the rail in the stretch but lacked a late response. MONTE BAJO (FR) had good position, failed to respond. KNIGHT'S QUEST raced five wide throughout. OH MY GOLD raced in the second flight throughout. QUIET FRONT was away alertly, set the pace, gave way. ONE PRIZE had good early speed, flattened out. QUICKKISSER failed to menace. BOOMERANG STAR bobbled at the start, was no threat.
