**Footnotes**

REDJET'S PROMISE led inside, dueled and was headed in the stretch, then prevailed under a strong drive. RIKI MCD stalked the pace four wide, rallied at the quarter pole but couldn't get past the winner. BIG TRUMPET stalked the pace three wide, bid at the three-eighths pole, dueled in the stretch, ducked in past the eighth pole and out at the sixteenth pole, bothering a rival. He was disqualified and placed fourth after a stewards' inquiry. OFFICER MOO LA MOO was bumped at the start, raced three wide, bid at the quarter pole, was steadied, then was checked in the stretch and lost momentum. BROOKLYN BOUND bid belatedly five wide. SARATOGA BADGE saved ground to no avail. BEYOND THE OCEAN pressed the pace for a half mile before giving way. GOOGLY faded while racing three wide. SUN VALLEY AL was not a factor. FREE AND FLASHY was off awkwardly. FIRST REQUEST hopped at the start.
